Project description:	The finca is formed by 32 Mayan families, who fought together in the		
	civil war as guerrillas, coming up for the Mayan people. After the war they achieved to obtain Finca Santa Anita, and form an entire community with two schools, a daycare centre, library, pharmacy and ecotourism project. But the coffee harvest makes up the main activity of this special community.

tasks:	mornings you can work on the communal land, or work with families on their own plots. These are the activities concerning the coffee harvest: Jan - Feb: prepare the field and the trees to obtain firewood		
	•	March - April: collect the firewood	
	-	May - June: some families start to plant the new coffee trees	
	Sep - Dec: coffee harvest and processing.
