Project description:	This educational community center was founded in 2004 in order to address shortcomings in the Guatemalan national education system, particularly in Quetzaltenango and its surrounding communities. The project is located on the outskirts of Quetzaltenango in a sector called Pacajá, and it's a fully licensed non-profit organization funded by its Spanish language school.	
Description of volunteer tasks:	<p>Morning program: Teaching English or any other subject to youth. Or general classroom assistance. As the classrooms are small, it's preferred that volunteers contribute with their own subject, handling the class by themselves, and rotate along the different grades during the morning.</p> <p>Afternoon program: Recreational activities with children, homework help, specific reinforcement. On Tuesdays and Thursdays in the afternoons, there are also English lessons for local youth.</p>	
Opening hours:	Always, but for volunteers from 7AM – 4:30PM	
Requirements:	Spanish level:	Proficient
