Number of permanent employees:	3 (a cook and 2 nanny´s). A local teacher works voluntarily.	
Project description:	This project is for parents of limited resources. It´s a daycare where the (single) parent can bring their child while they work. The kids receive pre-kinder lessons, behavior training and recreational time. The project foresees in breakfast, snack, lunch and snack. Parents only pay a symbolic amount of Q100 per month. At the moment there are 15 kids registered, they have a capacity for 25 kids. All kids are between 3 months and 5 years old.	
Description of volunteer tasks:	Volunteers are needed to take care of the kids, as they´re all very young and active. It´s simply playing, or doing some creative activities like arts and crafts, dancing, or teach them some English. You can also help in the kitchen to prepare the food, and help the kids eat. Or accompany the kids when they have an excursion.	
Opening hours:	Monday to Friday from 8:00am to 5:00pm	
Requirements:	Spanish level:	Basic
	Minimum time commitment:	1 week
	Work schedule:	Preferably the afternoons.

How to get to the project:	By foot, it´s a 10-minute walk from the Parque Central.	
Closing dates of the project:	From Dec. 15 th to Jan. 3 rd they´re closed, and during national holidays.
